Members may do the entire trip, or just join the group for the four days in NYC. The cruise ships is the RCCL Anthem of the Seas. Current prices are around \$2,400 per couple for the cruise. It embarks from Cape Liberty New Jersey on Sept 14, with stops at ports in Boston, MA, Portland ME. Bar Harbor, ME, Saint John, New Brunswick (Bay of Fundy), and Halifax, Nova Scotia. In Boston, the United States' oldest city, you can see where Revolutionary history took place on a walking or trolley tour along Boston's Freedom Trail. Portland's heart is the lively Old Port of narrow cobblestone streets and restored brick warehouses filled with shops, restaurants, cafes and bars. Bar Harbor, ME, was a wealthy summer playground during the Gilded Age, where the Acadia National Forest welcomes visitors to its rugged beauty and serene parkland. 
